BROOKLYN, NY. Tuesday, December 10, 2019 – Bishop Nicholas DiMarzio, a protege of disgraced Cardinal Theodore McCarrick, and Bishop Edward Scharfenberger formerly of priest of the Diocese of Brooklyn have not, to this point, spoken fully of their knowledge of alleged abuse by McCarrick, retired Bishop Howard Hubbard of Albany or recently resigned Bishop Richard Malone of Buffalo.

To date, under both their watches, the Diocese of Brooklyn has evaded a full account of the avoidable tragedy of clergy sexual abuse.

Both continue to manage internal Church procedures which protect perpetrators because of the confessional secrecy which they enforce on behalf of the Church.
