The recent Buffalo News article about the 1995 report to the Buffalo Diocese of alleged sexual abuse of a minor girl by Fr. Fabian Maryanski indicates that the Buffalo Diocese continues to cover-up and conceal information, documents and files it has on credibly accused clergy sexual abusers

Bishop Richard Malone, despite his promise of transparency to victim/survivors of sexual abuse by clergy, has not revealed the number or names of credibly accused clergy sexual abusers in the Diocese of Buffalo. It is time to practice transparency

Children, teenagers, and vulnerable adults continue to be at risk in the Buffalo Diocese because Bishop Richard Malone continues to cover-up and obfuscate regarding clergy sexual abuse. The lack of transparency is preventing many victims from trying to heal
